

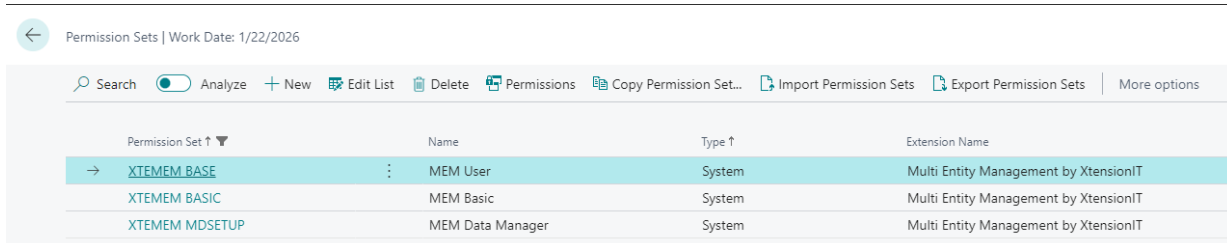
FAQ: Permission Set

This FAQ document (Frequently Asked Questions) covers questions related to the Permissions Sets for Multi Entity Management.

This FAQ apply for Multi Entity Management, version 6.7.0.xxxx and later.

1. Permissions Set

When installing Multi Entity Management, three Permissions Set are created.

XTEMEM BASIC	MEM Basic	System	Multi Entity Management by XtensionIT
XTEMEM MDSETUP	MEM Data Manager	System	Multi Entity Management by XtensionIT

XTEMEM Basic (MEM Basic): This Permissions Set must be assigned to every User in the Environment. This Permissions Set apply Execute-permission to all XTEMEM tables and Read-permissions to all other objects. This allows Multi Entity Management to check if the User data operation is allowed in respect to the Master Data setup.

XTEMEM Base (MEM User): This Permissions Set must be assigned to Users in Companies which are publishing or subscribing master data. The XTEMEM Base permission only need to be assigned to users which are working with data managed by Multi Entity Management.

This Permissions Set apply permission to daily use and configuration of normal Master Data Management setup.

XTEMEM MDSETUP (MEM Data Manager): This Permissions Set must be assigned to Users which managed Master Data or the Setup of Multi Entity Management.

This Permissions Set apply all configuration rights to Multi Entity Management.

2. Multi environments

When setting up a Microsoft Entra Application for a Multi environment subscriber, the Entra Application must be assigned the following permissions.
